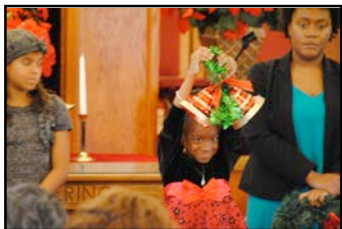
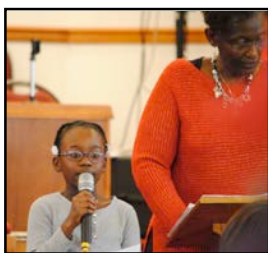

CHRISTMAS PROGRAM

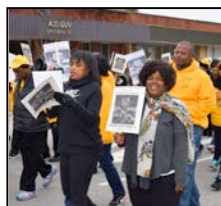

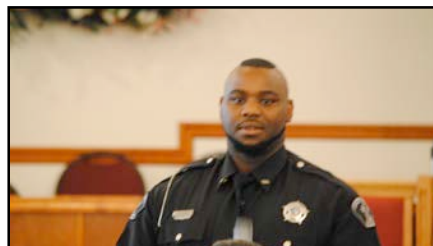
YOUTH PARTNERS WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT

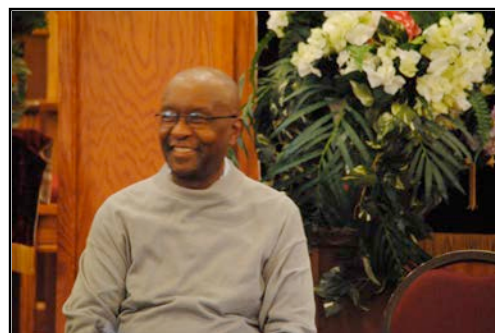

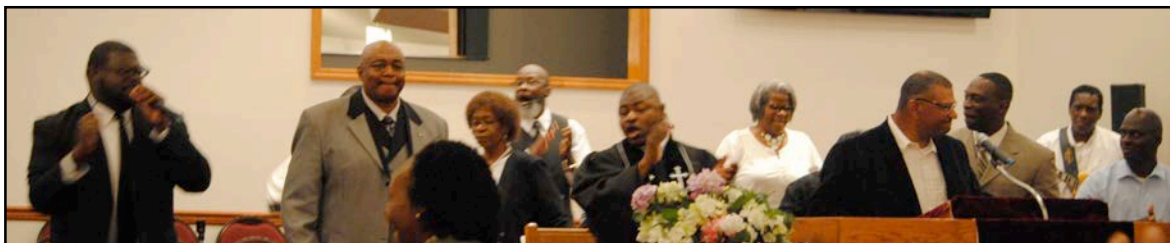

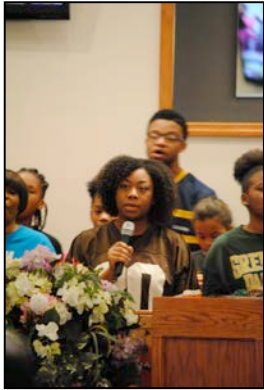

Alaijah Williams – Topic: "Making it With Jesus"

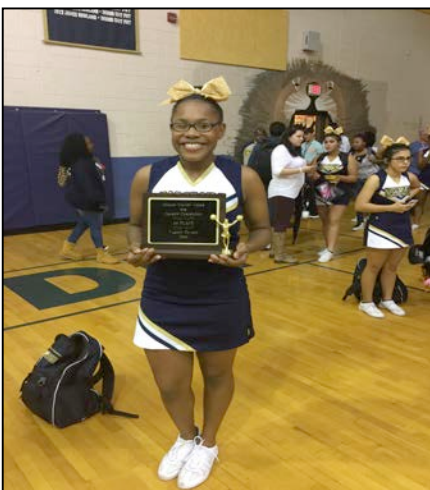
Age 15-18: Reverend Donnie Hester Award

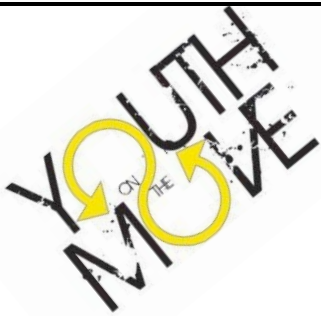


KIERRA PARRAMORE

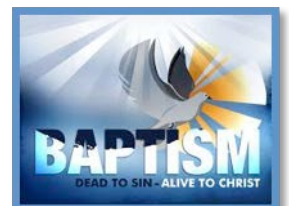

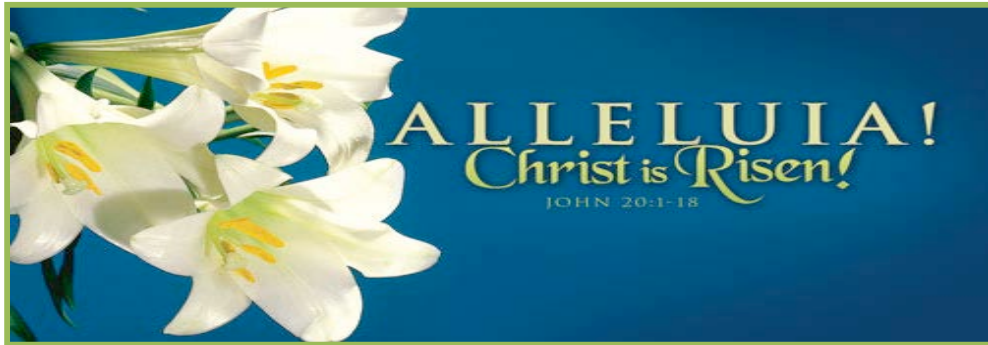
